To ALL Planholders:

The following changes, additions and/or deletions are hereby made a part of the Contract Documents as fully and completely as if the same were fully set forth therein:

One of the addants from the Pre-Bid Meeting that occurred on February 7th, 2024 posed several additional questions to the project manager, the questions and answers are described below.

ADDITONAL:

1. Is a bid bond required for this RFP:

A bid bond is not required for this project.

2. Are performance and payment bonds required:

Yes, Benton County contracting protocols require a performance and payment bond for construction contract RFPs.

3. The Pre-Bid Meeting was mandatory. Will contractors that did not attend the site walk be eligible to submit a response:

No, they will not be eligible.

4. What is the gage of metal for the new metal roofing:

Currently unknown.

5. The existing metal panels are made of short pieces, not continuous from top-to-bottom. Can the new panels be one piece top-to-bottom:

Yes.

6. Is the new roofing material to be pre-painted or field-painted:

Project manager will accept contractor's preference.

7. What is the roofing material over the front entry of the subject facility:

Built roofing material.

8.	Is the front entry roof area included in this RFP/project: No, it is not included in the scope of work.
9.	Is the flat roof area above the back site entry also metal: Yes.
10	No, see RFP Addendum No. 2 for more information on this subject.
11	Is the metal cap on the outside of the gutter to be replaced:
12	There are three sizes of roof panels on the project, 12", 18" and 34", is this to be matched or are materials to be all one size: All one size is sufficient.
13	Can scaffolding be set on the jail roof with roof protection: Yes.
14	Is an earlier start date possible: Yes.
15	Have permits been applied for: Permits with the State Historic Preservation Office and the Corvallis Historic Resources Commission have both been pursued. Construction and building permits have not been applied for.
16	Who is responsible for paying permits: The contractor is responsible for permit cost.
